Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Advanced Health Workers (OO4) or Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Generalist Health Worker (OO3)

Employment Status: Full-time with consideration given to part-time

About the roles:

The Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health Worker will be responsible for the delivery of advanced clinical primary health care services that assists in the prevention, early detection and management of health issues in Yarrabah and surrounding areas. In collaboration with other health professionals and in response to community health needs in Yarrabah and surrounding areas the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health Worker will work in partnership with the community and other government departments to address these needs. Previous experience highly desirable but not necessary.

Essential Requirements/Selection Criteria:

- A current driver's license.
- A minimum of Certificate III in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Primary Health Care
- The applicant **MUST** be in possession of or have the ability to obtain a valid Positive Notice Blue Card issued by the Commission for Children Young People and Child Guardian prior to commencement of employment. - The applicant **MUST** have a current Police Clearance or be able to show via a valid receipt that they have recently applied for one.

- Previous experience preferred
