

## MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION FORM

### 5. Membership of the corporation

#### 5.1 Members on registration

- (a) A person only becomes a member when the corporation is registered, as long as the registration complies with the Act.
- (b) Members names must be entered on the register of members.

#### 5.2 Members by application

##### 5.2.1 How to become a member after registration

A person becomes a member if:

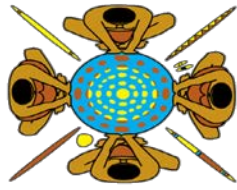
- (a) The person wants to become a member and applies in writing.
- (b) The person is eligible for membership.
- (c) The directors accept the application.
- (d) The person's name is entered on the register of members.

##### 5.2.2 Who can apply to become a member (eligibility for membership)?

- (a) A person who is eligible to apply for membership must be an individual who is at least 18 years of age and an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander person and a resident of Yarrabah
- (b) Membership of the Association shall be open to adult Aboriginal and Islander persons who are residents elsewhere but the directors will determine that it is proper for the person to be a member

##### 5.2.3 Membership application

- (c) A person (the applicant) who wants to become a member must apply to the corporation.
- (d) The application must be in writing.
- (e) The application must be attached with the applicant's proof of Aboriginality, which can be in the form of a Proof of Aboriginality form, Centrelink letter or a letter from an Aboriginal organisation verifying the applicant's claim to Indigenous Australian status."

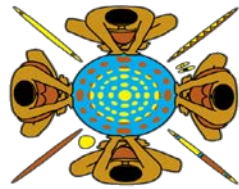
